

JCCS CENTRALIZES CONTRACT SERVICES, VENDOR REGISTRATION, AND BUSINESS TOOLS IN CONTINGENCY ENVIRONMENTS

Overview

The Joint Contingency Contracting System (JCCS) is an Information Technology (IT) system utilized by contingency programs that rapidly deploy for humanitarian, peacetime, and wartime missions. Theater Contracting Commands and Host Nation (HN) vendors access the JCCS web site for accurate and up-to-date contingency business information.


Over the last decade, JCCS has supported DOD and federal organizations' stakeholders in 20 Iraq and 13 Afghanistan Regional Contracting Commands, and 10 Special Operations Command contracting offices throughout the world. The program has expanded into Africa and Central Asia as the U.S. government engages in new business in those regions.

Capabilities

JCCS provides centralized vendor registration and solicitation/proposal postings on the web site, with English and Arabic capabilities. Theater Contracting Commands and Host Nation (HN) vendors access the JCCS web site for accurate and up-to-date contingency business information. In addition to the JCCS system, a suite of services and web-applications are provided. The JCCS platform provides a secure and flexible Service-Oriented Architecture (SOA) which enables new contingency applications to utilize JCCS' existing infrastructure to reduce software development lead-time and cost.

Key Features

- Host Nation vendor management for centralized registration, solicitation
 posting, proposal receipt, and past performance. Tracks banking information for
 vendors who select EFT as their payment method.
- Host Nation contractor vetting
- Contract data capture; supports contract closeout and historical data reference
- Simplified reporting utilizes JCCS and Army Contracting Business Intelligence System (ACBIS) tools. Advanced search capabilities for ad-hoc reports
- Dashboard for command message posting for situational awareness



JCCS is part of the Joint
Contingency & Expeditionary
Services (JCXS), a program under
the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA)
Information Operations (J6). JCXS
is the information technology
system used by contingency
programs that rapidly deploy for
humanitarian, peacetime, and
wartime missions. JCXS provides

a secure web site.

CENTCOM - Joint Theater Support Contracting Command (C-JTSCC) utilizes JCXS in Regional Contracting Commands (RCCs), throughout Afghanistan and other nations, that deliver contingency services to all the major DoD components: Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marines; and report to other DoD and Federal Government stakeholders to include: United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and Department of State (DOS). JCXS is a repository for more than 45,000 Host Nation vendors and other international vendors.
