916th CCBN Contracting Personnel receiving 3in1 Training

916th CCBN Training at Ft. Sam Houston, TX

As the 916th Contingency Contracting Battalion (CCBN) prepares for its upcoming Digital Training Exercise in early 2017, the Joint Contingency & Expeditionary Services (JCXS) Program has partnered with them to provide training on JCXS systems deemed critical to successful execution of the mission. On 7/21 and 7/22/2016, a team of JCXS trainers provided JCXS applications training to the 916th CCBN at Ft. Sam Houston, TX. During this engagement, 3in1 trainers demonstrated the 3in1 Tool system to approximately 20 U.S. Army contracting personnel. As the 916th CCBN routinely deploys personnel to SOUTHCOM, the July 2016 3in1 Tool system training was critical in providing personnel of the 916th CCBN with the knowledge they will need to utilize the 3in1 Tool system during future rotations and increase their effectiveness as U.S. Army contracting professionals.

WHAT IS JCXS?

The Joint Contingency & Expeditionary Services (JCXS) is DoD's global provider of expeditionary acquisition business solutions. JCXS provides agile capabilities in a dynamic and time-sensitive environment, while supporting interagency collaboration.

WHAT IS 3IN1?

3in1 is one of many JCXS modules. 3in1 is a joint procurement and financial solution developed to reduce risk to the field team, improve procurement and cash management on the battlefield, and provides immediate visibility into purchases/payments.

3in1 at Tinker Air Force Base

On 6/21 and 6/22/2016, the JCXS Program teamed with contracting personnel from the Air Force Sustainment Center (AFSC) at Tinker AFB, OK to deliver JCXS systems training. As a primary driver of this engagement, the 3in1 team provided relevant information on the 3in1 Tool's usage by the United States Air Force and led the class through four hands-on 3in1 Tool device exercises. The 3in1 Tool device emulator, an application allowing replication of the 3in1 device screen on a projector, was successfully utilized to demonstrate the 3in1 device's interface in the AFSC classroom setting. Additionally, the new-and-improved 3in1 v3.6 Website was demonstrated, including the SF44 clearing and reports generation features; these features garnered numerous positive reviews from training attendees. Overall, the attendees appreciated the benefits of the 3in1 Tool and sought to add it to their "contracting professional toolbox."
