## 3in1 Demo at Ft. Belvoir

Belvoir, the 3in1 Team demonstrated the 3in1 Tool's capabilities to a veteran group of 25 Contracting Officers supporting the DLA Joint Contingency Acquisition Support Office (JCASO). Subsequently, the trainees were able to gain valuable hands-on experience using the 3in1 Tool by placing orders, clearing orders, and viewing reports. In the coming months, these KOs will be asked to deploy throughout the world in support of various DOD contracting missions. By familiarizing themselves with the 3in1 Tool prior to deployment, these mission-critical contracting personnel will be well on their way to utilizing the 3in1 Tool once their boots hit the ground.

## 3in1 TRAINING AT YOKOTA AIR BASE, JAPAN

The 3in1 Team built a relationship with TSgt Freeling from his previous 3in1 Training at Lackland AFB, Texas. TSgt Freeling felt the 3in1 Tool would bring value to the 374th Contracting Squadron (CONS) at Yokota Air Base, Japan and showed interest in receiving training. The 374th CONS provides operational and specialized contracting support to 374th Airlift Wing, 5th Air Force, U.S. Forces Japan, and U.S. Army, Navy and Marine Corps installations in Japan. They also provide single source authority on mainland Japan for utilities, telecommunications and transportation including an 18,000-person master labor contract.

Two 3in1 Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) provided four days of 3in1 training to Contracting Officers, Finance Officers, and Finance Technicians. Training topics included: hands-on exercises using the 3in1 device, registration into the 3in1 system, report generation, and the purchase and clearing processes. The 374th plans to test/field the 3in1 Tool in their upcoming exercise for FY16.
