AGATRS v3.2.11 is now available!

Import from Excel capability. When operating in a latent or offline environment, AGATRS users can download the [AGATRS Order template](#) to track all transaction data at a line item detail level.

Once logged into AGATRS, this spreadsheet can be imported to the system creating draft orders for review, validation, and submission.

DoD Contingency Business Environment (CBE) Mandate

JCXS Cited in DFAR Policy-PGI 218.2

When supporting contingency operations, as defined in the CBE Guidebook and DFAR 3.101 Policy, two JCXS tools are currently mandatory: the 3in1 Tool and AGATRS.

"No other electronically tools may be used to fulfill the same capabilities as the 3in1 tool and AGATRS".
